


ChartMaker® Clinical Release Notes

ChartMaker® 2018.2 (fv6.3.7)

Important Notifications

- Upgrade from Microsoft Server 2008 and Windows 7 In January 2020, your Windows 7 workstations and Microsoft 2008 Servers will no longer be supported. Even with security patches, <u>problems may still arise</u> if you choose not to upgrade. In addition, your workstations will no longer be HIPAA compliant. To avoid potential issues in the future, contact our <u>Technical Services Department</u> today.
- SQL Server 2016 & the ChartMaker 2018.2 (File Version 6.3.3) Upgrade Beginning with ChartMaker 2018.2 (File Version 6.3.3) Upgrade, a warning message will appear upon the completion of the upgrade regarding the transition of the ChartMaker Medical Suite to using SQL Server 2016, for those offices where an automated upgrade to SQL Server 2016 was not possible. See the figure below. If you are receiving this message, to avoid potential issues and to ensure your system remains HIPPA compliant, it is important to contact either STI Hardware Helpdesk, or your software vendor, to review your options.

Added Features

Additional Services — A new Additional Services menu has been added to Clinical that lists the various services that
STI Computer Services offers, allowing you to easily find out more information regarding these services as needed.
See Figure 1. After an option has been selected, a dialog will appear briefly outlining the selected service, as well as
providing contact information so you can learn more about that service. See Figure 2.

- **Direct Messaging Import into Chart** The system has been updated so when importing a CDA file for a patient, via the **Import into chart** button in the Direct Messaging dialog, the chart note that contains the document import will now include a Patient Assignment button. See Figure 3. This allows you to easily enter and capture patient assignment information for incoming transition of care patients to ensure that the Clinical Information Reconciliation performance measure is calculated correctly for MIPS 2019.
- **Import Patient Data** The system has been updated so that when importing CDA file via the Import Document dialog, the chart note that contains the document import will now include a Patient Assignment button. See Figure 3. This allows you to easily enter and capture patient assignment information for incoming transition of care patients to ensure that the Clinical Information Reconciliation performance measure is calculated correctly for MIPS 2019.




Figure 4 - Confirm Medication - Proxy




Figure 5 - Message Detail - View

Medications – Confirm Prescription – The Confirm Prescription dialog has been updated so that when a user, with a Prescribing privilege of Proxy, is confirming a prescription for E-Prescribe, the Pharmacy will be activated allowing that user to select a pharmacy prior to confirming the prescription. See Figure 4. When a Pharmacy is selected in the Confirm Prescription, the message sent to the prescribing physician's To-Do List will contain that pharmacy information, allowing the doctor to save time when queuing and sending that prescription. See Figure 5.

- The Note Tab Order Procedure Immunizations The program has been updated to ensure that the latest CVX codes and CVX mappings, MVX codes and MVX mappings, Manufacturers, and NDC codes, per the latest CDC guidelines, are used for immunization procedures.




Figure 6 - Vital Signs Entry

- **The Note Tab Vitals –** The Vital Signs Entry dialog has been updated so the Additional Information column for the Pulse and Pulse 2 sections will now have **Intensity** and **Rhythm** drop-down fields, allowing you to configure an intensity and a rhythm for the corresponding pulse, if applicable. See Figure 6. When these either of these items are configured, they will output into the chart note with the corresponding pulse.

• **System Login** – The **Did you know?** section, on the right side of the Sign in to Clinical screen, has been updated to include links (**Enroll Here**, **Learn More Here**, **Register Here**, **Sign Up Here**) to our website, that will provide you with additional information or enrollment opportunities for the applicable feature item highlighted in the login screen.
